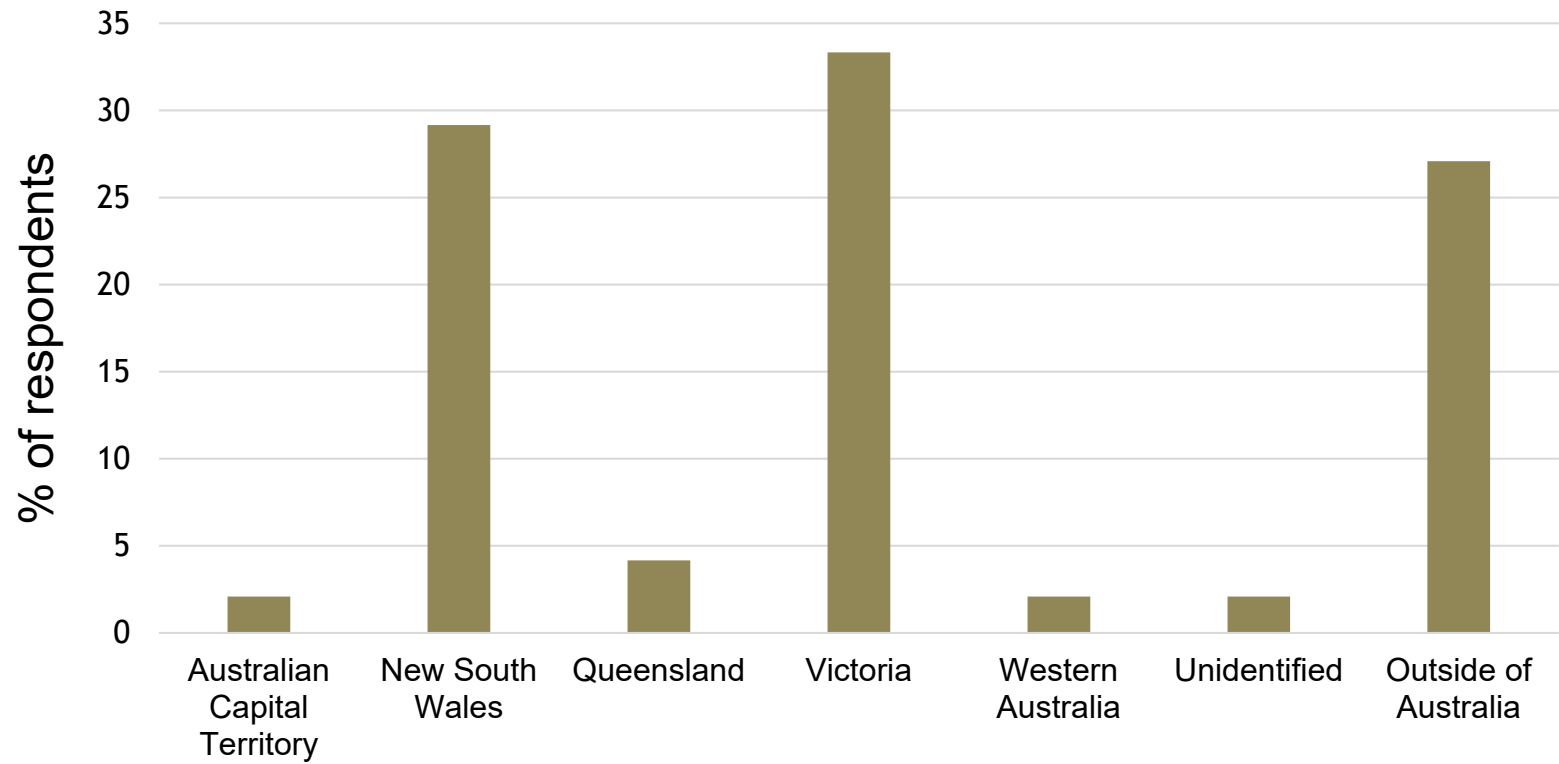

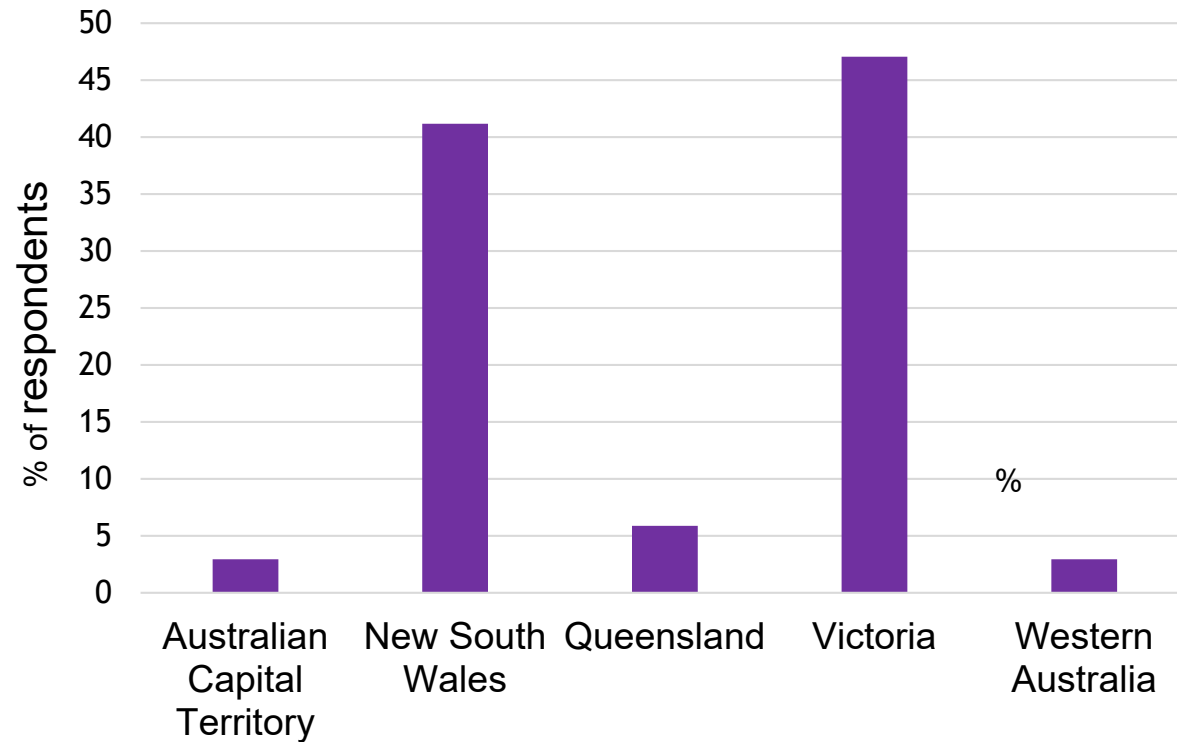
# Survey on ACIS membership demographics

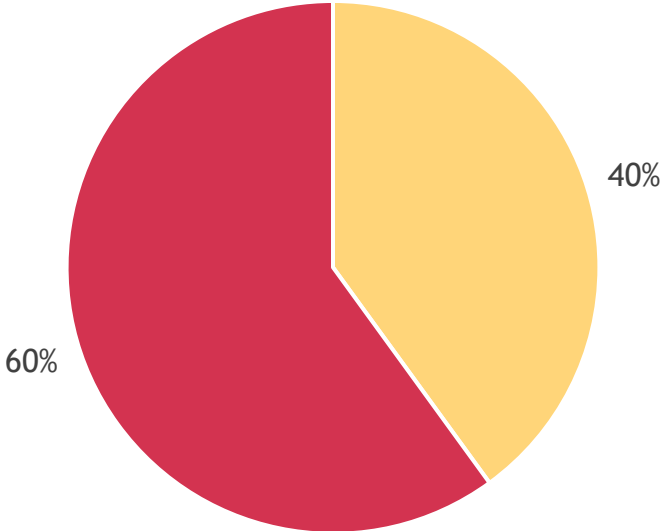


# Geographic Location within Australia



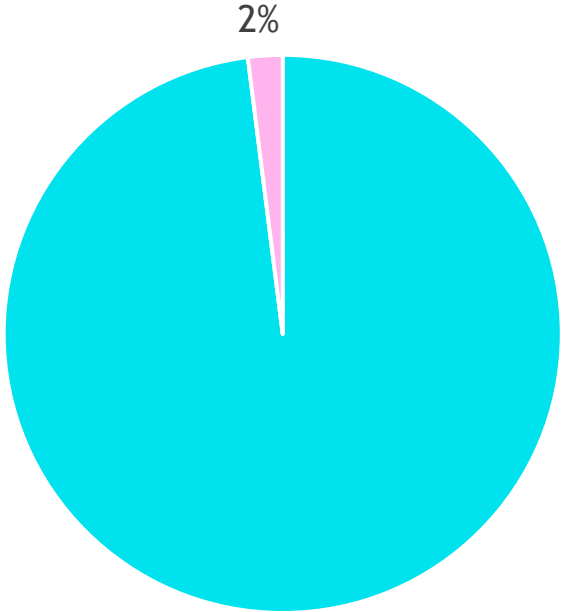

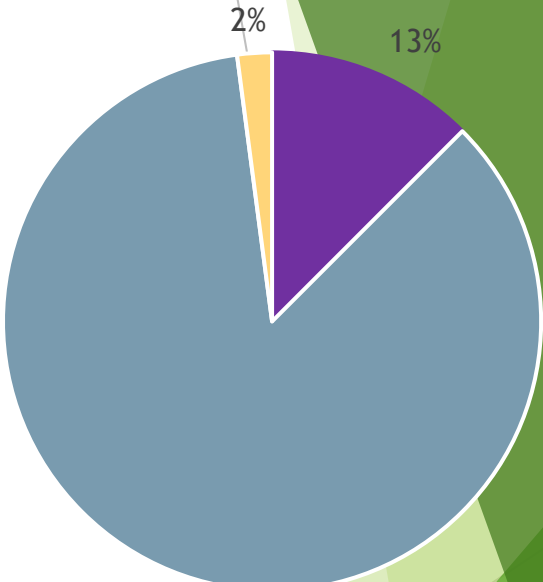

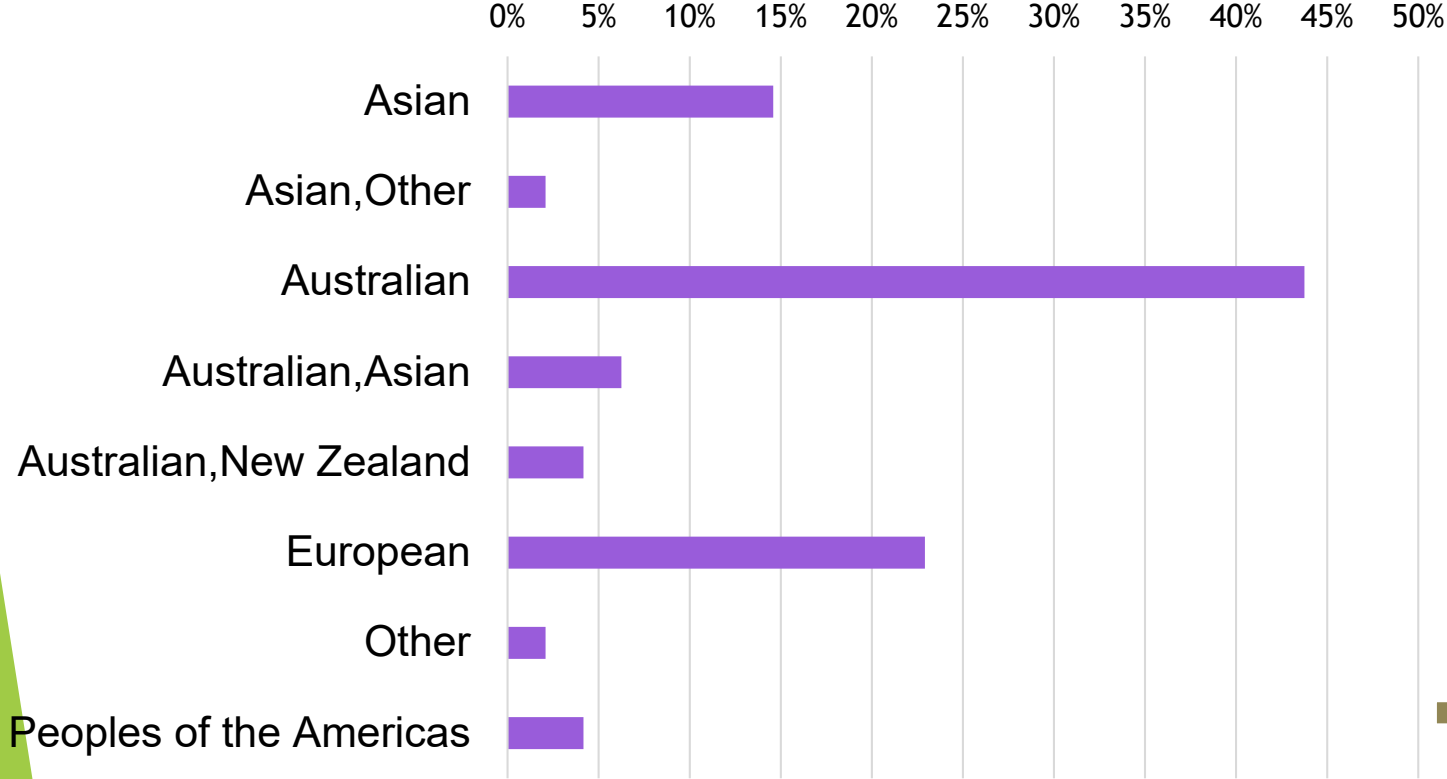
Sexual Orientation



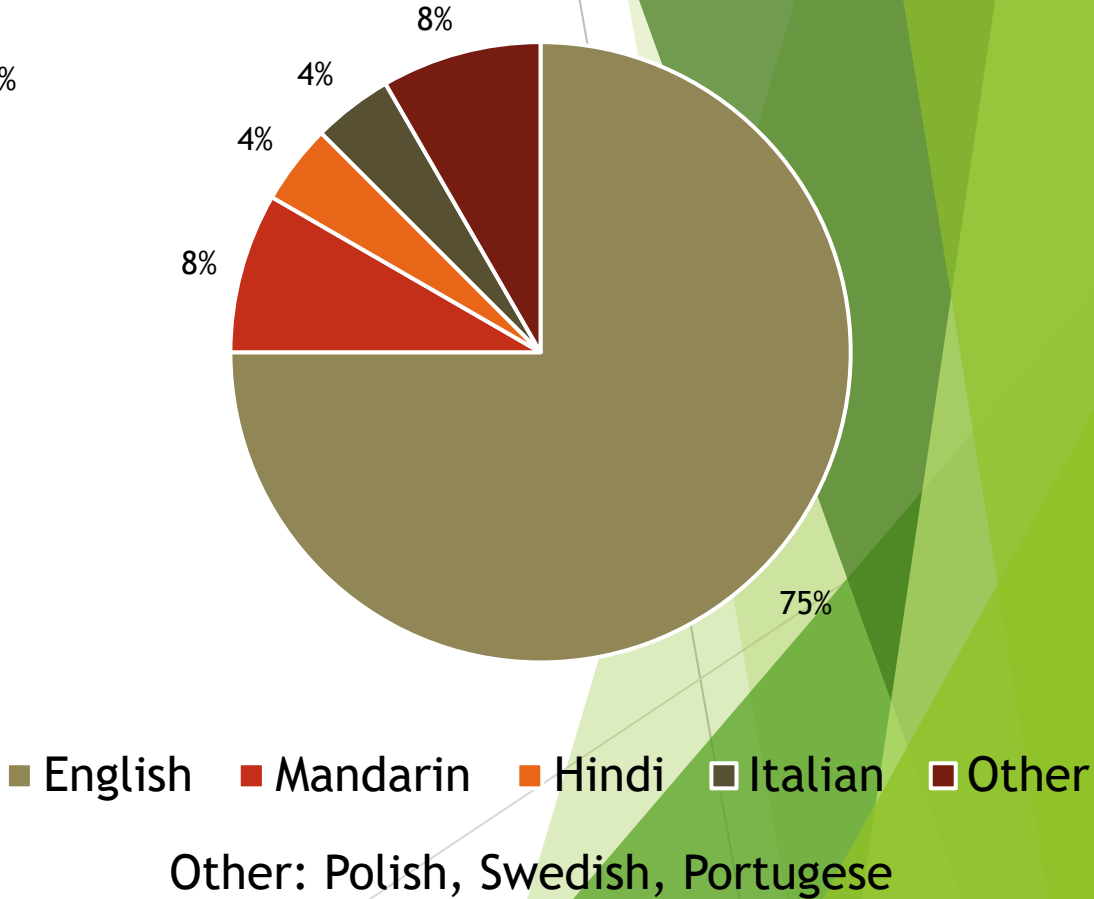

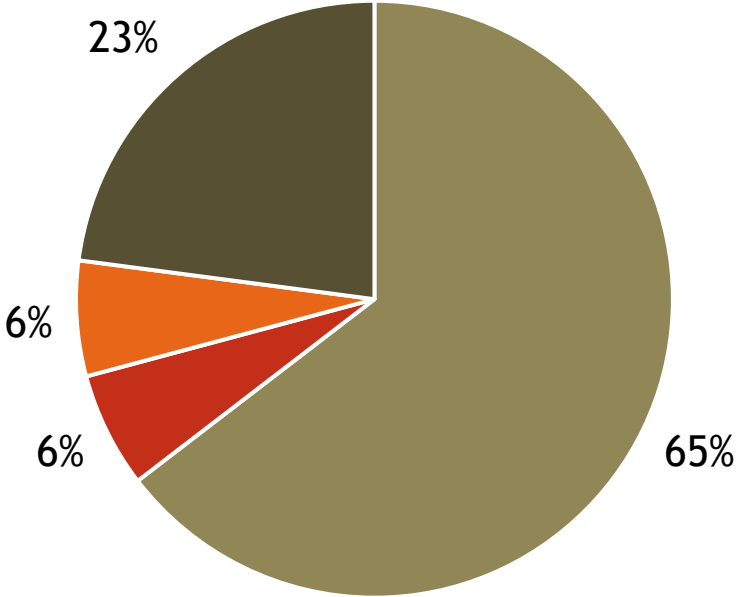

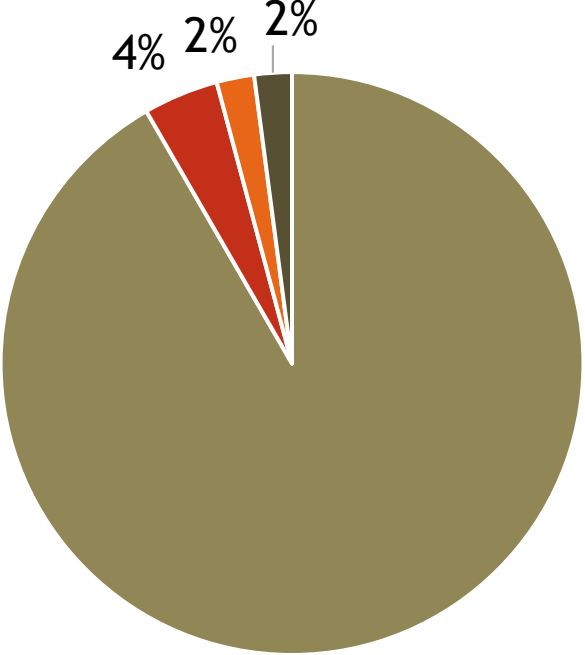

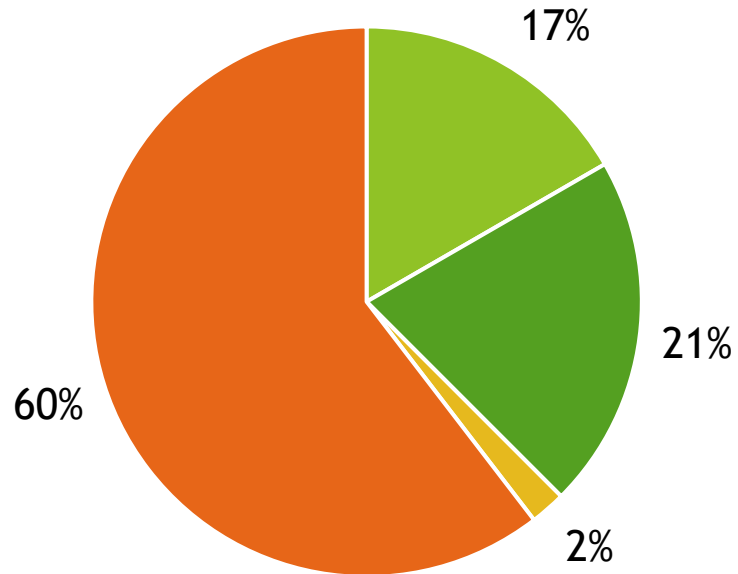
