



## Call for Award Nominations

The American Chemical Society (ACS) is soliciting nominations for  
**two awards in the fields of colloid and surface chemistry**

Nominations are due November 1, 2016

### **2018 ACS Award in Colloid Chemistry**

**Purpose:** To recognize and encourage outstanding scientific contributions to colloid chemistry.

**Eligibility:** The nominee must have made outstanding scientific contributions to colloid chemistry. Nominees are not required to be members of the ACS, and they can live and work outside the United States.

**2017 Recipient:** Nicholas A. Kotov, University of Michigan.

### **2018 ACS Award in Surface Chemistry**

**Purpose:** To recognize distinguished services in the advancement of surface chemistry.

**Eligibility:** A nominee must have demonstrated extensive contributions to the advancement of surface chemistry. Activities recognized by the award may include such fields as teaching, writing, research, and administration. Nominees are not required to be members of the ACS, and they can live and work outside the United States.

**2017 Recipient:** Cynthia M. Friend, Harvard University.

Note: A nomination includes one recommendation letter (submitted by the “nominator”) and one or two support letters. One support letter is required. A second support letter is optional, but strongly encouraged. Nominators are not required to be members of the ACS. Any individual may submit either one nomination or one support letter for each award.
